


We also led a Festival Teesside assembly in Whinney Banks - considering how God can make a little into a lot!


Church



Our EXPLORE group this half term has taken us to the wild, wild west - learning how we are a part of a big family tree, called to praise at all times and be a part of God's plan... or you could say, learning to become a Rootin', Tootin', Fruitin' cowboy!







In Mini Praise, we have been using the same teaching framework as we do in our schools work. Debs looks for educational and sensory activities to allow the children to learn and develop with the support of their caregiver (parent/grandparent) and its all linked into our craft, story and song time. Take a look at what we got upto at the beginning of April when we looked at the story of Breakfast on the Beach!



We used magnetic fishing rods to catch fish in the Orbeez.

The kids loved putting their hands in the little jelly beads and letting them fall through their fingers ...(so did Debs!)

We used sensory fish to do some fishy maths sums - all of them adding upto a maximum of 10.
One side of the fish had dots to count, the other side had numbers making it accessible to most age ranges.





Last Saturday our fabulous Ambassadors, held a coffee morning for us. What a turn out it was! We had some of our BiG props out on display so that you could see the scale of the work we do up close and personal!





Lots of cake was consumed, as well as litres of tea and coffee.

Festival Teesside is happening, this summer!


Saturday 8th & Sunday 9th June
